



Public Notice Yuma County Four Year Modified Plan 2025-2028 For Public Review and Comment

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requires the Yuma County Workforce Development Board, in partnership with the Yuma County Board of Supervisors, to prepare, review, and submit modifications to the local plan at the conclusion of the first two years of the four-year planning period. The plan must identify and describe the policies, procedures, and activities that are provided in the local area (Yuma County), consistent with the State plan.

The ARIZONA@WORK–Yuma County Workforce Development Plan 2025–2028 Modified Four-Year Plan will be available for public review and comment for a 30-day period from August 11, 2026, through September 11, 2026.
